

Government funding for employers for fmi frontline management programs

.....government funding

Government Funding of \$4,000 per eligible employee is available to employers for both new and existing eligible employees who register for the Certificate IV in Frontline Management qualification with the Frontline Management Institute (fmi). The funding is available in NSW, QLD and SA. In Victoria it is only available for new employees of less than three months.

This funding is paid directly to the employer organisation and can provide substantial funds for the delivery of these programs.

Funding is usually **\$4,000 per eligible employee** paid

\$1500 initially (about 3 months from enrolment by the time they pay out) and

\$2,500 upon completion (again a couple of months delay).

The traineeship is for two years normally but you can have a program for 12 months or longer and at the end of the program apply for early completion of the traineeship once the qualification is gained.

.....eligibility

Funding is generally provided for employees who are Australian residents and who have not gained any nationally recognised Certificate, Diploma or Degree qualifications in the last 7 years in Australia.

To find out which employees are eligible employers should contact an Australian Apprenticeship Centre (AAC) to check this out. If you do not already have an AAC please contact us and fmi can recommend an AAC which has given a great service to employers on our programs



...the fmi Certificate IV in Frontline Management Program

Delivery of the program with fmi can be in any of three ways or a combination of these ways:

1. In house group of your people trained in your workplace or a venue of your choosing (ten units of one day each)
2. Public courses at fmi Sydney see fmi Calendar for dates (ten units of one day each)
3. Open Learning – people are sent the program by email or on a CD (ten units)

It is also possible to have people do the Certificate IV in Frontline Management and then later do an upgrade conversion program with us to the Diploma of Management,
