

## fmi communities scholarships for participants in fmi training courses

### .....fmi communities scholarships

The Frontline Management Institute has made available a limited number of **fmi communities scholarships** which provide 10% towards fmi standard fees for frontline managers or those moving towards this role in Community and Health not for profit organizations that are registered charities.

These **fmi communities scholarships** allow participants to complete the Diploma of Management or the Certificate IV in Frontline Management or fmi short courses.

**fmi communities scholarships** are available to both individuals and to organisations.



### .....eligibility

To be eligible participants must meet the following criteria:

1. Be an employee (full or part time) or volunteer for a not for profit registered charity that provides services to the community or health.
2. Be able to use the training to develop their competency in this employment.
3. Be willing to complete all requirements of the course including assessment if applicable

FMI Scholarships are available even if Government Funding (\$4,000 per eligible employee) is also obtained for the employer.

Scholarships are not available in conjunction with any other special offers from fmi.

Scholarships are available solely at the discretion of fmi and may be withdrawn in the future.

A set value of scholarships are made available each financial year.
